HOW DO I COUNT?

STEP 1: Find box on fence of pedestrian bridge.








STEP 2

Remove the clipboad, data sheet, and a pencil from the box




Also in the box

- Clicker for when lots of fish are moving (probably won't happen until 2020, but maybe we'll get lucky!)
- More data sheets

STEP 3

- SHAWSHEEN RIVER GREENWAY
- If you're the first counter on a new day, start a new sheet.
 - Either turn yesterday's sheet over or get a blank sheet from the box.
- Record the <u>date</u> on the data sheet, if it's not already there.
- Then record your <u>name</u>.



STEP 10



Record any notable things that occurred.

- I saw a huge snapping turtle!
- Aw man! I dropped the pencil in the river!
 - 2 huge carp swam upstream.







